Are we applying Jewish teachings to the factory farming of animals?



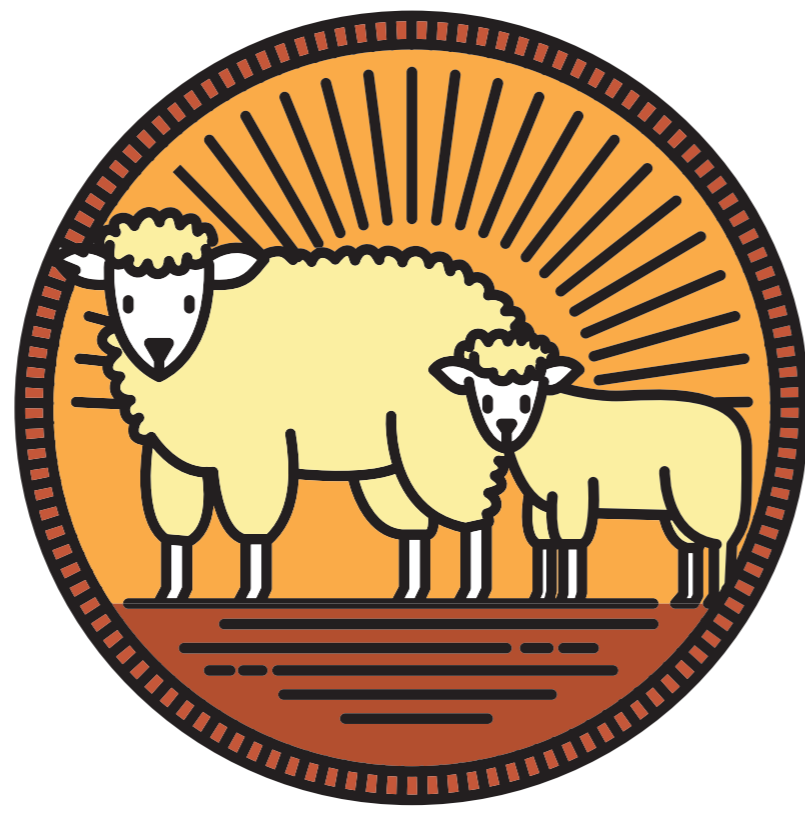

Deuteronomy 22:6-7



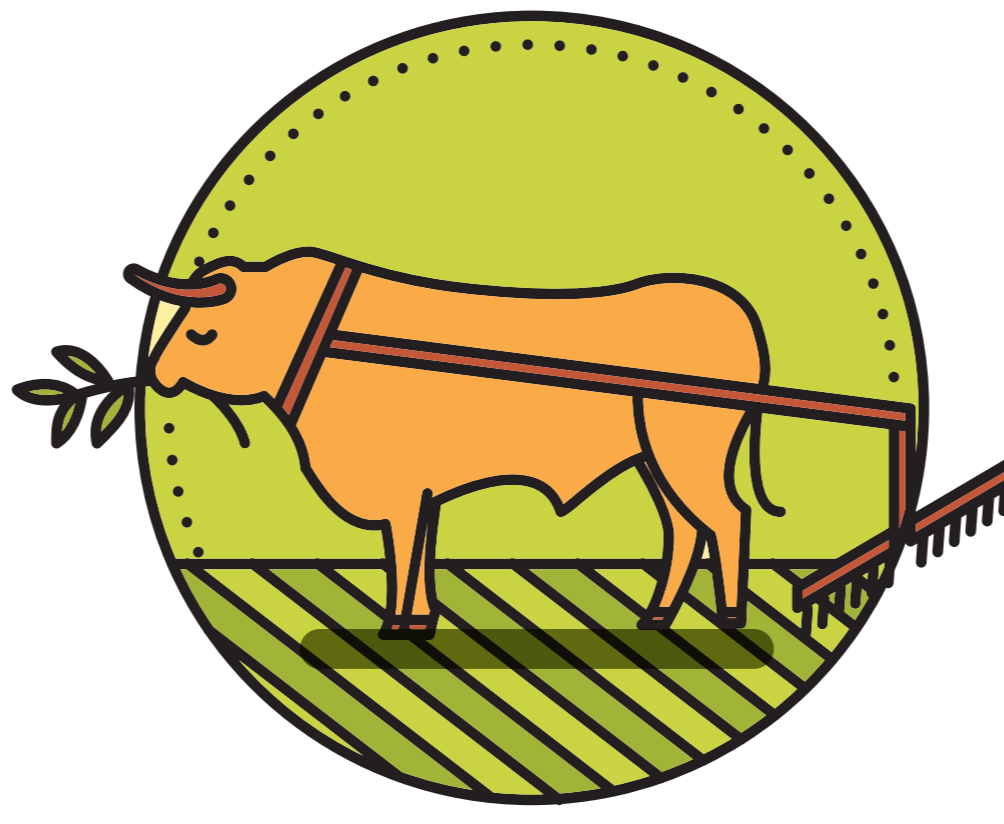
When you see the donkey of your enemy lying under its burden and would refrain from raising it, you must nevertheless raise it with him.

Leviticus 22:28



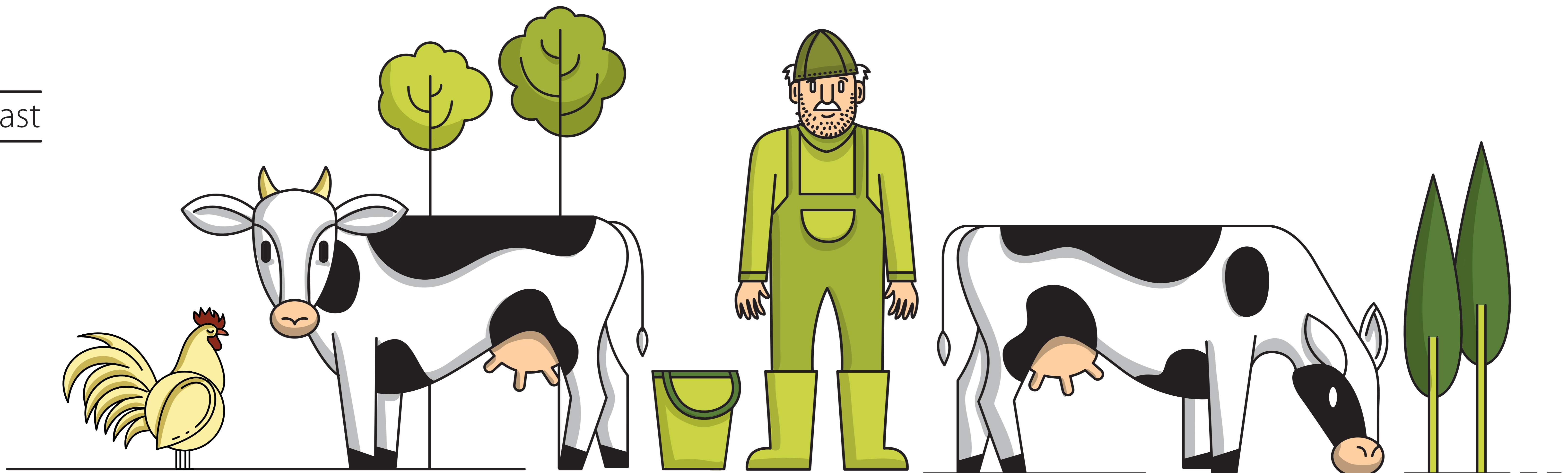
Six days you shall do your work, but on the seventh day you shall cease from labor, in order that your ox and your ass may rest, and that your bondman and the stranger may be refreshed.

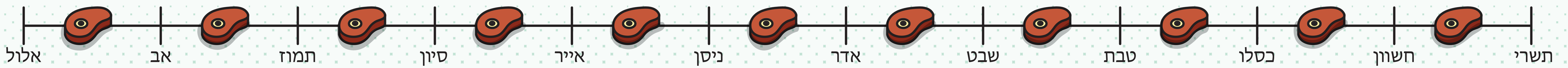

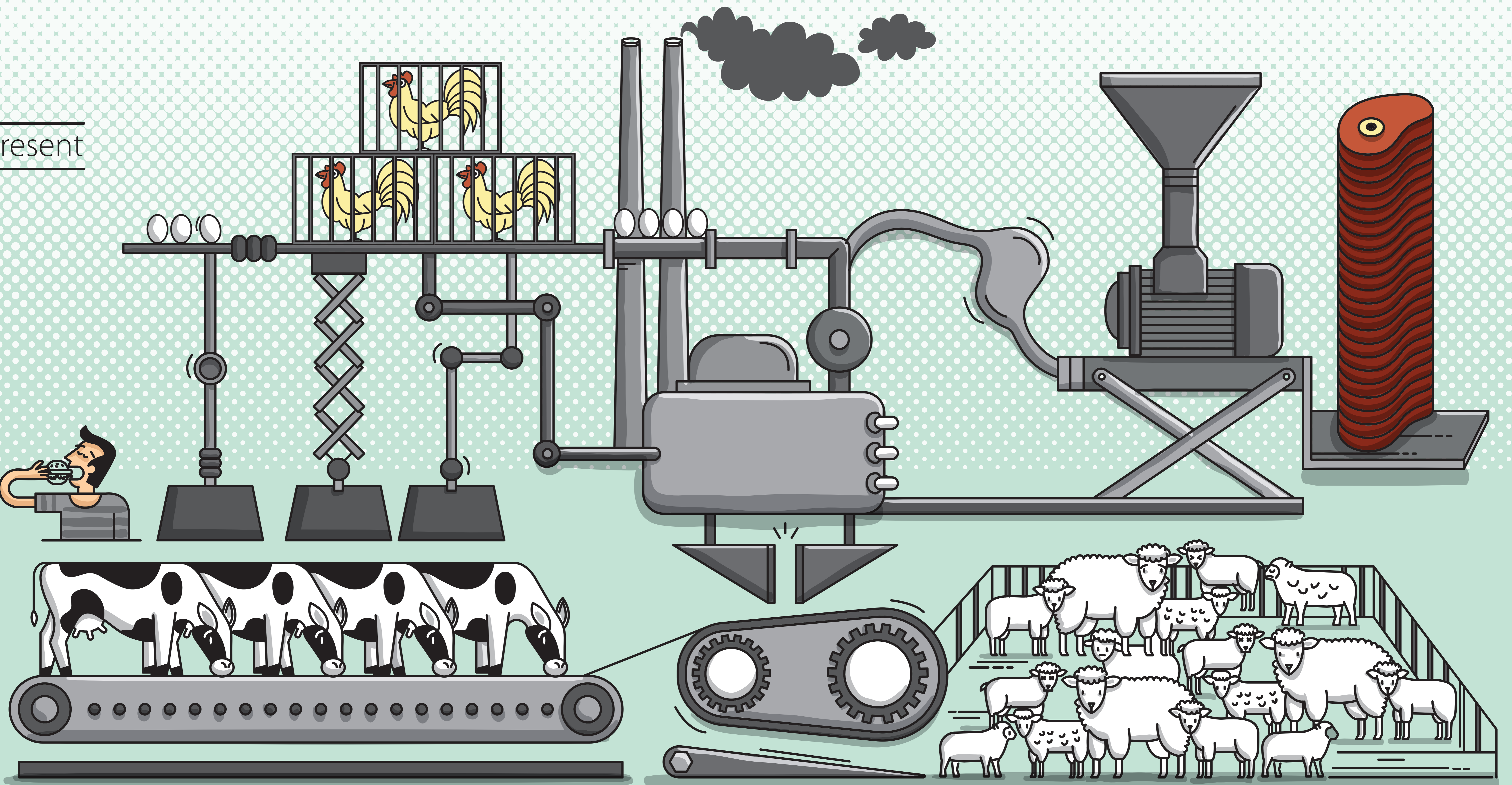
Past
